Purpose and legal basis of the data processing

The collection and processing of data serves to document and verify the self-disclosure of visitors in the context of the spread of the coronavirus.

The legal basis is Art. 6. para 1 lit. f) GDPR (legitimate interests) and the legal basis pursuant to Art. 6 para 1 lit. c) GDPR and the German Infection Protection Act (IfSG and BayIfSMV).

Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

The data is for internal use, and is only disclosed to the health authority upon request.

Transfer of personal data to a third country

Personal data is not transferred to third countries.

Period of storage of personal data

The data collected will be saved as part of the processing of the procedure and will be deleted after 4 weeks.

Rights of the data subject

You have the following rights under the General Data Protection Regulation:

- The right to information about your stored personal data (Art. 15 GDPR).
- The right to rectification of any inaccurate personal data (Art. 16 GDPR).
- If the legal requirements are met, the right to erasure or restriction of processing and the right to object to processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR). The right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

Should you exercise your above-mentioned rights, we will verify if the legal requirements exist to do so. You are also entitled to lodge a complaint with a competent data protection authority.
